- Must have a Bachelor of Nursing Degree from a recognized university or equivalent combination of education and experience as a registered nurse.
- Current Licence to practice with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba is required
- Current CPR Certification
- Minimum five (5) years experience in community health.
- Previous experience in an inner city community health/primary health care setting required.
- Demonstrated knowledge in the area of STI's, reproductive health and harm reduction.
- Knowledge and understanding of issues affecting the health of inner city residents
- Excellent interpersonal, organizational and communication skills (written & verbal) are essential
- Ability to work independently and within an inter-disciplinary team environment with respect, professionalism, co-operation, sensitivity and cultural awareness
- Knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal cultures and traditions
- Ability to work in a pro-choice medical facility in an inner city community and provide care using harm reduction principles.
